1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 Purpose

This document specifies the Lloyds Outward Reinsurance Status Reporting Message (LIMRIS) that is sent by DXC to inform LORS participants of the final status of their ORI items at the end of each working day.

The items reported in the message are those which have had some kind of movement made against them since the last LIMRIS message was sent. The movements may have been performed by the Broker (v2) or an Underwriter (v3), either interactively or via a data message, or automatically by the LORS application or by the LPSO.

For those valid message users for whom there are no items to report a null LIMRIS message is dispatched at the end of the working day.

1.2 References

This message was designed by the Corporation Of Lloyd's.

1.3 Field of Application

This message has been specifically designed for use within the Lloyd's Outward Reinsurance Scheme (LORS).

1.4 Functional Definition

Currently there are two defined LORS business applications for LIMRIS. This document defines the structure and content of the data message that satisfies the following functionality.

1.4.1 DXCDXC TO BROKER

DXC uses LIMRIS to provide Brokers with a report of the final status of their ORI items at the end of a working day. Only items which have had a movement applied to them, since the last LIMRIS messages were produced are reported. One message is transmitted, per User Number.

The message acts as an audit control between the Broker's system and the LORS database to ensure that they are kept in step with one another.

The sequence in which items are reported within the message is arbitrary.

1.4.2 DXC TO UNDERWRITER

DXC uses LIMRIS to provide Underwriters with a report of the final status of their ORI items at the end of a working day. Only items which have had a movement applied to them, since the last LIMRIS messages were produced are reported. One message is transmitted, per Syndicate Number.

The message acts as an audit control between the Underwriter's system and the LORS database to ensure that they are kept in step with one another.

The following fields are advised if a third party amendment has been made to the item being reported:

- Audit Code(s)
- Risk Code
- Tax Code
- Treaty / Excess Of Loss Indicator
- Year of Account

A third party amendment is an amendment made by an Underwriter, to one of the above fields on a composite ORI item, where the assured lines on the item belong to more than one Syndicate Group.

The fields are advised so that other parties on the item may respond to the amendment (e.g. authorise or object to the change) before the item is settled.

The above fields may also be reported when amended by an Underwriter, even when the amendment does not constitute a third party amendment. Each field is advised when it has been amended since its value was last reported to the Underwriter by either a LIMRIS or a LIMRIA message.

When the amendment of one of the above fields constitutes a third party amendment, all of the fields are advised. The Third Party Amendment Indicator is also advised.

When the amendment of one of the above fields does not constitute a third party amendment, only the amended fields are advised. The Third Party Amendment Indicator is not advised.

The sequence in which items are reported within the message is arbitrary.

2. MESSAGE DESIGN

The LORS Status Reporting Message (LIMRIS) does not require the use of sections.

3. MESSAGE DEFINITION

3.1 Introduction

The definition of an EDIFACT message that will satisfy a practical business application requires the unambiguous statement of:

- group and segment usage in the business context, which is defined in this appendix.
- the information hierarchy (the message structure), which is also defined in this appendix.
- the standard EDIFACT structures used to compose the message (refer to the LORS BatchSegment Directory in Appendix C).
- the code sets that will be used in the operational application (refer to the LORS Batch Code Set List in Appendix B).

3.2 Group and Segment Usage

3.2.1 PURPOSE

Most of the segments used in this message were designed to be applicable over a wide range of messages covering various commercial and administrative applications. This section is provided to give details of their particular use within this message.

3.2.2 USAGE

UNB, Interchange Header

A mandatory service segment starting, identifying and specifying a transmission. The Application Reference for the LORS Status Reporting Message is 'LIMORI'.

UNH, Message Header

A mandatory service segment starting and uniquely identifying a message. The message type for the LORS Status Reporting Message is 'LIMRIS'.

NAD, Name and Address

A mandatory segment identifying which member of the recipients user group (e.g. Broker Number or Syndicate Number) all items in the message relate.

DTM, Date and Time

A mandatory segment giving the date of the status report.

SEGMENT GROUP 1

A mandatory group of repeating segments. It contains details, including the status, of the ORI items which have had a movement against them since the last batch of LIMRIS messages were produced.

GIS, General Indicator Segment

A mandatory segment containing a code to show the status of the item.

NAD, Name and Address

A repeating mandatory segment detailing the originator of the movement and in messages to the Underwriter, the Broker.

GIS, General Indicator Segment

A repeating conditional segment which provides the values of any codes and indicators that can be amended by the Underwriters.

RFF, References

A repeating mandatory segment giving the references by which an item can be identified.

DTM, Date and Time

A conditional segment which provides the year of account of the item.

UNT, Message Trailer

A mandatory service segment sent to end and check the completeness of a message.

UNZ, Interchange Trailer

A mandatory service segment sent to end and check the completeness of an interchange.

The DTM segment is a London Market standard.

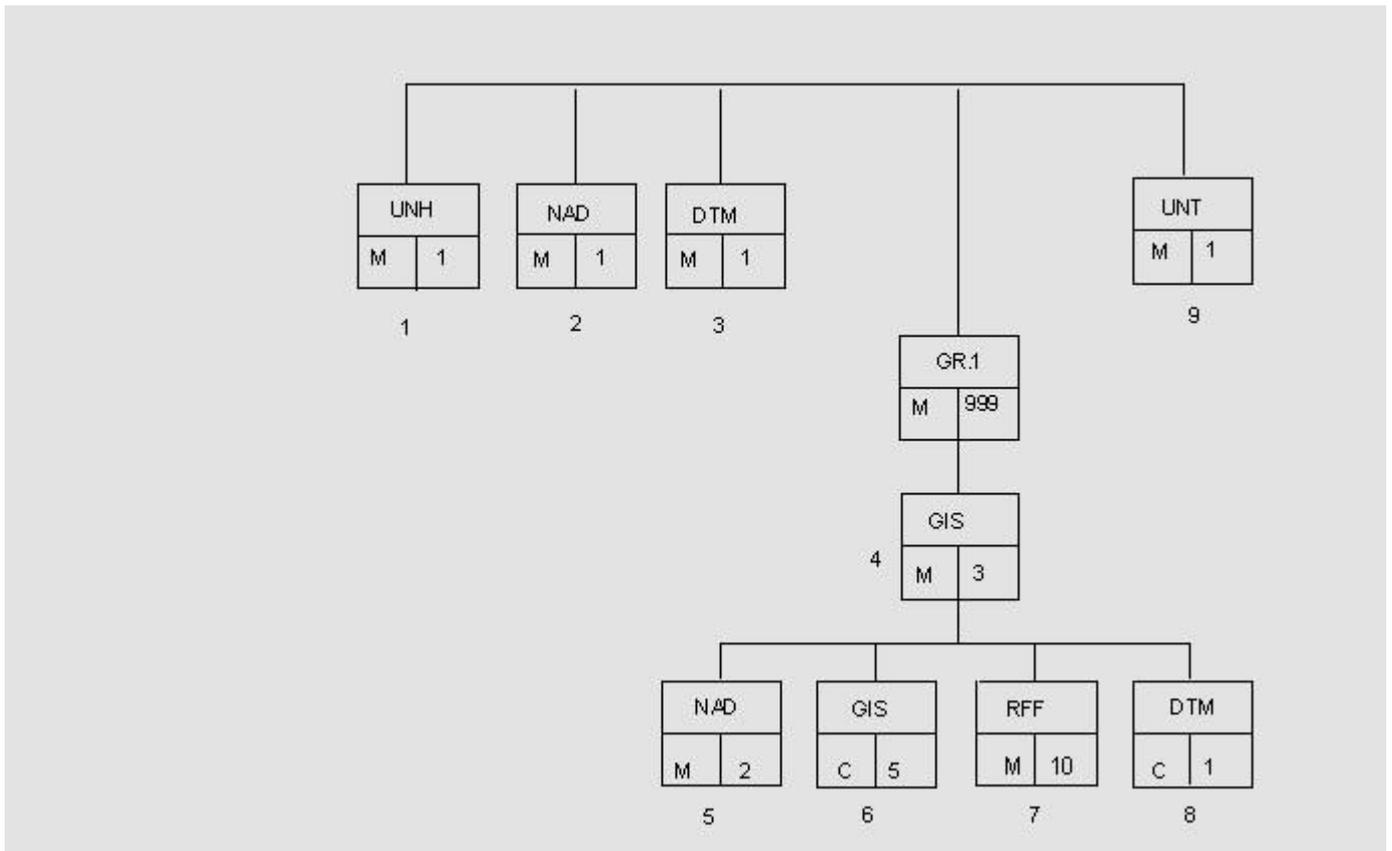
The GIS segment is drawn from the UN/EDIFACT Quality Control segment directory dated June 1990.

5. DATA MAPPING

The segments are listed in the order in which they appear in the message.

The number given in brackets after a segment tag refers to the number shown against the relevant box on the branching diagram in section 4 of this appendix.

The mandatory/conditional status of each data element is shown. This refers to the status of the element within the message and not within the specified segment.

Refer to section 6 of this appendix for the specific conditions that can apply for each LORS business application of LIMRIS.

Refer to section 4 of this manual (Security, Audit and Control) for details of the data mapping of the interchange and message header and trailer segments.

The format of the data elements shown below it is TCG standard, the length of a field may be affected by LORS validation rules (refer to Appendix E).

7. EXAMPLE MESSAGE

7.1 DXC To Broker

During the day, four movements were processed against three of a particular Broker's ORI items.

- The first item is one of a newly added group. It was authorised by the syndicate, but the item will not be extracted for settlement until all items in the group have been authorised.
- The movement against the second item was a cancellation submitted by the Broker. The item was settled in 1991 (i.e. it does not have a Unique Market Reference, Transaction Reference or Lloyds Item Number). A response has not yet been made by the Underwriter.
- The third item had two movements processed against it. It had been added by the Broker the previous week and today was the default date for its authorisation. At the end of the day it was extracted for settlement processing by the bureau application.

At the end of the working day DXC generated the following message to send to the Broker.

7.2 DXC To Underwriter

During the day, four movements were processed against three of a particular Syndicate's ORI items.

- The first item is a composite and one of a newly added group. It was authorised and amended by one of the Syndicates on the item. The item therefore has a status of 'partially authorised', and all Underwriter amendable fields on the item are reported due to the third party amendment.
- The movement against the second item was a cancellation submitted by the Broker. The item was settled in 1991 (i.e. it does not have a Unique Market Reference, Transaction Reference or Lloyds Item Number). A response has not yet been made by the Underwriter.
- The third item had two movements processed against it. It had been added by the Broker the previous week and today was the default date for its authorisation. At the end of the day it was extracted for settlement processing by the DXC application.

At the end of the working day DXC generated the following message to send to the Underwriter.
